



Hi everyone,

I hope this finds you all well and keeping safe.

Delivery of First Aid has changed quite considerably since before the pandemic started so I wanted to outline how the county will now be delivering Mod 10 from now on until things change, and restrictions have eased significantly.

Module 10 has been discontinued and has now been split into Mod 10A and Mod 10B. Once you have completed Mod 10a this be updated on compass, then once mod 10B has been completed this will also be updated and you will receive your certificate and booklet.

- Mod 10A
 - This is the theory element of first aid which will be delivered via 1 online session lasting approximately 2.5hrs delivered via the county's zoom account.
 - You will sign up for the course via the Eventbrite system.

- Mod 10 B
 - Mod 10B cannot be completed until MOD 10A has been completed.
 - This is the practical element. These will be 15minute drop-in sessions, open throughout the day.
 - You will need to sign up (via Eventbrite) to a 15-minute session before arrival, you will not be able to turn up without prebooking first.
 - Social distancing measurements will be in place as well as mandatory face masks (unless exempt) and strict hygiene routines followed.
 - The validation sessions will be held at M'Boro HQ on Tollesby Road (this can be found on google maps). The reason only one scout hut has been chosen is to reduce infection spread as much as is possible.
 - The practical element will consist of the approaching the scene and CPR (chest compressions only)
 - Full joining instructions, including extra COVID safe procedures will be sent by email to all those attending the 15-minute drop-in sessions.
