This is to make sure that everyone has the latest knowledge to keep everyone safe. It's also a requirement within our response to the Prevention of Future Deaths notice.

Thank you to everyone who's already taken the time to complete the learning. We appreciate the time and dedication you give to putting safety first.

If you've not completed the course yet, please make sure you've done it before the 14 July.

The learning can be completed in three easy steps:

- Sign into scouts.org.uk
- Head to My Learning
- Complete the course under 'The learning you need'

You can find support to help you complete the learning on our <u>safety learning support page</u>, including details on how to sign into <u>scouts.org.uk</u> for the first time.

Please take the time to complete this important course, if you haven't already. It's a vital part of how we continue to keep all our people safe in Scouts.







New Badge




